What is the EOSCpilot?

The EOSCpilot project is a two-year initiative funded by the European Commission to set the ground for the development of the EOSC.

Research Libraries consider the EOSC as a key in implementing Open Science across Europe. As such, the EOSC:

- ☐ Contributes to shaping a Culture of Data all over Europe
- ☐ Assists in developing skills, data stewardship and data management plans
- ☐ Supports implementing the FAIR principles
 - ☐ Findable & accessible: using digital infrastructures
 - ☐ Interoperable and reusable: developing a catalogue of services offered by e-infrastructures across all disciplines

Research Libraries play an important role in promoting the FAIR principles, and in building capacities for data stewardship, as they:

- ☐ Contribute to the development of skills and competencies through local training and train-the-trainer activities
- ☐ Support adopting and monitoring data management plans
- ☐ Facilitate incorporation of FAIR principles in data management plans, digital preservation practices, and policies
