

Science is mired in a "replication" crisis. Fixing it will not be easy.

Nobody Can Repeat Them.

Waste of (public) money, negative effects on public trust in science!

Overcoming these hurdles

Transparency \diamond Challenge findings \diamond Stop publication bias \diamond Improve methodology \diamond Preregistration

Define the research questions and analysis plan prior to observing the research outcomes; deposit the protocol in a registry.

Unfortunately, adoption rate is still very low. Reasons could be:


- Ambiguous reward systems for the stakeholders involved (publishers, editors, authors)
- A lack of integration of preregistered protocols into research and publication workflows

Missing decision aids in case of deviations from the preregistered methodology

Solution: Offer preregistration services


Preregistration services at the Leibniz Institute for **Psychology Information (ZPID)**

- A searchable and trusted registry (PsychArchives)
- Support for easy creation and deposit of protocols into a disciplinary repository (in preparation)
- Free data collection in ZPID online and offline labs as a reward for preregistering protocols in the ZPID registry (incentive)
